### Why pharmacovigilance is needed ???

- ❑ Tests in animals are insufficiently predictive of safety
- ❑ In *Clinical trials* patients are selected - may miss rare ADRs
- ❑ Conditions of use in trials differ from practice - may miss drug interactions
- ❑ Duration of trials is limited - may miss ADRs after years
- ❑ Special groups (such as children, elderly, pregnant women) - not involved
