

It is certified that:

- a) The applicant owns 25 acres of land and manages a 300 bedded hospital
- b) It is desirable to establish a medical college at Suraram Cross Roads, Qutubullapur Mandal, Ranga Reddy District in public interest.
- c) Establishment of medical college at Suraram Cross Roads, Qutubullapur Mandal, Ranga Reddy District is feasible.
- d) Adequate clinical material as per the Medical Council of India norms is available. It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the medical college as per MCI norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, that State Government will take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the college with the permission of the Central Government.
